Immunization Guidelines

- We encourage you to schedule appointment with Occupational Health/Immunization Nurse or Primary Care Provider to receive immunization.
- In order to receive immunization, you must have documented visit with healthcare provider at PCMC within the last 3 months. In lieu of this, an order from your PCMC provider will be accepted.
- We request a copy of your immunization records be on file. If they are not currently on file, we request that you obtain a copy for our records.
- 2 vital signs must be recorded before your immunization.
- Education regarding vaccine will be provided to you before immunization. In turn, we will require informed consent before administering immunization.
- Following administration, we request that you wait in waiting room 15 minutes to ensure no adverse reaction to immunization.
- We are unable to administer immunizations with certain insurance carriers. Please check with billing department before your appointment.
- Pediatric immunizations are based upon guidelines from pediatrician. Please check with your pediatrician for specific immunization schedules.
